## **VETERAN OF THE MONTH - ZIMMERMAN POST 560**

This month we are honoring a veteran that only joined the Kriesel-Jacobsen Post 560 family a short time ago. Our Veteran of the Month for September is . . . our own Gary Lore.

Gary has been a member of The American Legion for 16 years, but a member of the Kriesel-Jacobsen Post 560 family for only the past 5 years. He has served our Post in various ways, including as Gambling Manager, and currently he is our Finance Officer. Gary and his wife Debbie have 2 children, 1 girl, 1 boy. Debbie is also a member of American Legion Auxiliary Unit 560.



Gary proudly served our country in the US Army from 1980 through 1983. He went to basic training at Fort McClellan, AL. After basic he stayed in Alabama and was trained at the Military Police School. During his time in the Army, Gary achieved the rank of SP-4 and earned several awards including – Humanitarian Service Medal – Korean Service Medal – the Army Service Medal.

Upon completing training at Fort McClellan Gary was designated as 95B Military Police. He was then stationed at Fort Riley, KS with the 1st Infantry Division, 716th MP Co. During that time, he was deployed to Fort Chaffe, AR (a Cuban refugee detention facility). His next and final duty station was a year and a half at Camp Casey, South Korea with the 2nd MP Co.

Some of the things Gary liked about his time in the Army were meeting new friends, travelling, and sightseeing when he had the time, but especially being there when people needed help. On the military side he enjoyed shooting the M60 machine gun from the top of a moving jeep and flying in helicopters with his Warrant Officer friends when they needed helicopter flight time. He also enjoyed rappelling out of a Huey and urban combat training.

Some of the things Gary disliked about his time in the Army were long hours in a tower guarding refugees, riots, and breaking up fights. Also not being able to help people when they needed it. Another drawback was the fact that communicating home was so difficult. At one point he was only able to talk to his mom once in a year and a half.

As most of us would understand, Gary has many stories he likes to share from time to time, but as Gary put it, "It is difficult to recall a story that is appropriate for this audience'. He did say that he enjoyed the year and a half he spent in Korea, even though it was one of the most dangerous places in the world while he was there. He found the people were very appreciative of our presence there. He is looking forward to a trip he and Debbie are taking back to Korea this Fall, as part of KDVA (Korea Veterans Association).

So, next time you see Gary, be sure to thank him for his time in the Army. Maybe even buy him a drink and see if you can get him to tell one of the stories that are 'inappropriate for this audience."
